Hydrogen diggers get green light to use roads

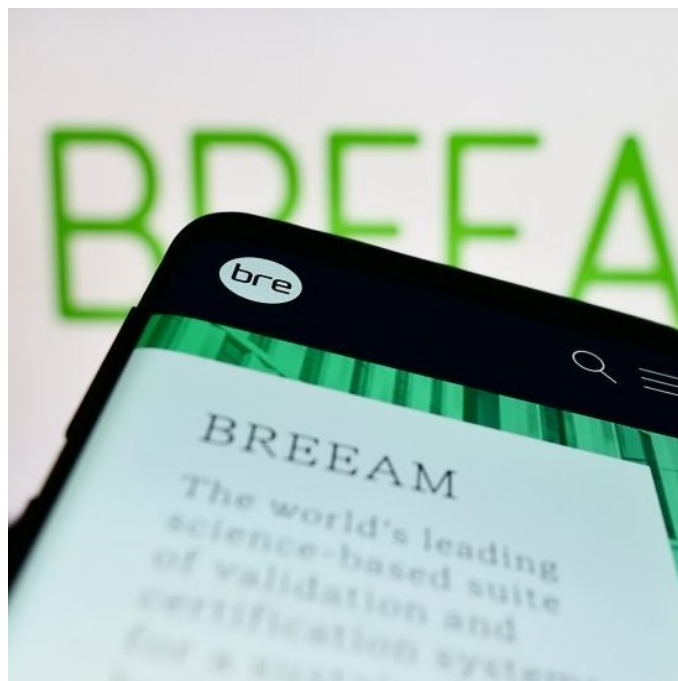
Hydrogen-powered diggers could soon be a regular sight on UK roads after the government changed the law to allow the green machines to drive between building sites.

UK Government invests £300m to build domestic supply chains for wind farms

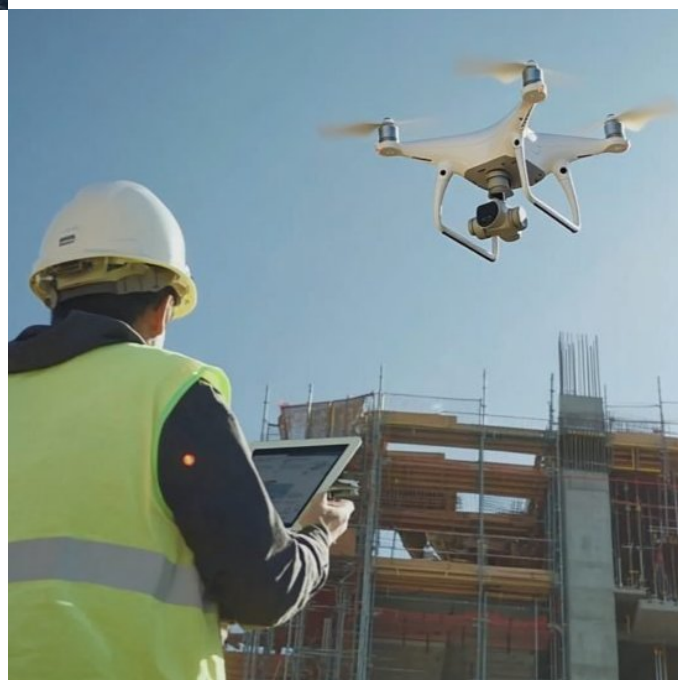
The UK Government will funnel £300m of funding to the development of domestic supply chains for offshore wind, reducing the nation's reliance on imports and creating new manufacturing jobs.
